Ripe for the Picking Revelation 14:14-20

- 1. What is the most elegant VIP reception you have ever received? What is it that you will never forget?
- 2. The Apostle John saw two visions of harvest. What are the similarities and differences between these two harvests?
- 3. The first harvest is wheat, and the second harvest is grapes. They are all ripe, and harvesting is urgent. If you could choose a color to describe your current mood, what color would you choose? Why?
- 4. Who do you think is the one who sit on the clouds in the first harvest, like the Son of Man, with a golden crown on his head and a sharp sickle in his hand? (The twenty-four elders also wear golden crowns. The Old Testament prophet Ezekiel is also called the Son of Man. He will receive instructions from another angel coming out of the temple)
- 5. Although the reaper is not the Lord Jesus, he should still be a heavyweight angel. Why does the harvested wheat receive such special VIP reception?
- 6. In the parable of the wheat and the tares, the angel went out and separated the wheat from the tares. Wheat and tares coexist in the crops. Although it is difficult for the human eye to distinguish them, they cannot escape the discernment of the reaper angel. How can you seriously examine your own wheat identity one more time?
- 7. How does the vision of the harvest seen by John support you to continue to wait patiently under the crowds of so many tares?
- 8. The angel who commanded the task of harvesting grapes was "who had charge of the fire, came from the altar." What does the appearance of fire remind you of?
- 9. The ripe grapes were thrown into the great winepress of the wrath of God. How does John describe this final judgment?
- 10. After seeing these two harvest visions, do you have the desire to be wheat instead of grapes? What obstacles can you foresee? How are you going to overcome them?
